

Resolution #2014-05

To Prohibit Truck Traffic over 7,000lbs on North St., Burr Oak St. and Berrien St. (North of Mulberry)

Purpose and Finding: MCL 257.726 allows a municipality to regulate or prohibit truck traffic on streets within its jurisdiction. The City has received numerous complaints from citizens regarding the excessive noise and vibrations caused by commercial and industrial vehicles traveling certain residential roads. These issues are being primarily caused by trucks with weights over 7,000lbs. The additional regulation of truck traffic in this manner will further promote the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Albion.

Council Member French moved, supported by Council Member Krause, to approve the following resolution.

RESOLVED, that trucks or other commercial vehicles, with a total weight of 7,000lbs or more, shall be prohibited from traveling on the following streets:

1. North Street;
2. Burr Oak Street;
3. Berrien Street (North of Mulberry only);

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that should the driver of any truck or commercial vehicle violate the above described restrictions and prohibitions, the Albion Department of Public Safety is authorized to cite the driver of the truck or commercial vehicle accordingly pursuant to Albion City Ordinance 82-276.
