A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE SENDING TWO NEW PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICERS TO THE POLICE ACADEMY

Purpose and Finding: As the council is aware, over the past year, the Public Safety department has seen staff reductions from retirement and resignations. In order to continue to provide the citizens of Albion with the same level of service that they have become accustomed to, it is necessary to hire additional public safety officers. The City is seeking to hire two new public safety officers who will require police training. As such, it is necessary for them to attend the police academy and become MCOLES certified. The cost of attendance for each of these officers will be \$9,200.00 per officer. The cost of their attendance will be covered through the difference in wages as new employees and the more senior employees they are replacing. Given that this expenditure exceeds \$5,000.00, council approval is required pursuant to Ordinance 2-384.

Council Member Barnes moved, supported by Council Member French, to approve the following resolution.

RESOLVED, that the City Council authorizes the expenditure of \$18,400.00 for the Albion Department of Public Safety to send two new officers to the police academy.


