ORDINANCE #2013-11

AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE JUMPING OR DIVING FROM PUBLIC BRIDGE OR
OVERPASS AS MISDEMEANOR; EFFECTIVE DATE OF SECTION

Purpose and Finding:

Michigan law provides for the crime of Jumping or diving from public bridge or overpass as misdemeanor; effective date of section in MCL 750.493E. The City of Albion does not currently have an ordinance specific to this offense, and to date offenses of this type have been referred to the county for prosecution. Given that this is an offense that occurs with a degree of regularity, it is in the interests of the City of Albion to have an ordinance for this offense to protect and the public at large.

THE CITY OF ALBION ORDAINS:

Sec. 58-40. AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE JUMPING OR DIVING FROM PUBLIC BRIDGE OR OVERPASS AS MISDEMEANOR; EFFECTIVE DATE OF SECTION

1. A person shall not jump or dive from a public bridge or overpass.
2. A person who violates subsection (1) is guilty of a misdemeanor. Punishable by a fine of up to \$500.00 and/or up to 93 days of jail time.


This Ordinance shall take on August 1, 2013 after publication in the Albion Recorder.
